

# Where to Park at the West Sac Center

The SCC - West Sac Center shares a cul-de-sac with the City of West Sac Community Center and the Arthur Turner Library.

★ **Sacramento City College students, staff, and faculty should park in the designated LRCCD parking lot.** ★

The **time-restricted** and **designated parking spots** should be **prioritized** for senior citizens, library customers, and electric vehicles.

*Please park appropriately to avoid getting a parking ticket.*

Please observe and follow the designated parking and time-restricted parking signs.



# How to Get to the West Sac Center

The SCC - West Sacramento Center is located at 1115 West Capitol Avenue, West Sacramento, CA 95691

## DRIVING

### From Interstate 80

1. Merge onto US-50 East/Capitol City Freeway
2. Take the Jefferson Boulevard exit
3. Turn north on Jefferson Boulevard (turn right if heading west, turn left if heading east)
4. Turn right on Merkley Avenue
5. Turn left into the LRCCD parking lot entrance

### From Downtown Sacramento

1. Travel west on Capitol Mall
2. Cross Tower Bridge and continue on CA-275
3. Take the Jefferson Boulevard exit
4. Turn right on Jefferson Boulevard
5. Turn right on Merkley Avenue
6. Turn left into the LRCCD parking lot entrance

### From I-5 / CA 99

1. Merge onto I-5 or CA 99
2. Exit I-80 West/San Francisco
3. Merge onto US-50 West
4. Exit Jefferson Boulevard
5. Right on Jefferson Boulevard
6. Right on Merkley Avenue
7. Turn left into the LRCCD parking lot entrance

## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

### Commuting from West Sacramento

The closest bus stop is near the corner of West Capitol Avenue and Merkley Avenue.



### Commuting from Main Campus

If you are using public transportation to travel to/from the main campus to the West Sacramento Center, then you can take **the Blue Line (SacRT) and connect to Route 42A (YoloBus)**.

The bus trip is approximately 49 minutes long.

### Getting here from the SCC Davis Center

If you are using public transportation to travel to/from the Davis Center to the West Sacramento Center, then you can take **Route P (Davis Unitrans) and connect to Route 42B (YoloBus)**.

The bus trip is approximately 1 hour long.

## VIA RIDESHARE

The City of West Sacramento works with [Via](#), a transportation technology company, to provide **residents, employees, and visitors with on-demand rides** from anywhere in West Sacramento to anywhere in West Sacramento. Please note that Via Rideshare will not transport you outside of West Sacramento city limits.

To use the service, download the [Via Rideshare App](#). Then, set up an account. Turn on your device's location services so the app knows where to pick you up. Enter your destination and request a ride. After the ride is scheduled, proceed to the pick-up location at the scheduled time.

### Pricing

\$3.50 per ride
